Annual report for the project Margrethe Hald: the Life and Work of a Textile Pioneer. New insights and perspectives

During the year, the Margrethe Hald research group have fulfilled a number of the goals for the project. We are very happy to share our results for 2021 with everyone interested in Hald's research and the project.

We have had lots of help from student assistants and interns Pernille Højfeld Nielsen, Line Maria Mørch, Mathilde Sonne and Anine Aakjær Lundgaard Jensen who have shared our news on SoMe, the CTR homepage and the Traditional Textile Craft homepage.

1) Highlights of 2021:

The Margrethe Hald database and the photo archive are now accessible to everyone interested. Thanks to our competent student assistant Anine Aakjær Lundgaard Jensen who created the database, it is now possible to study Hald's slides from her stays in the Middle East in 1960 and 1961 as well as her five-months journey in Latin America in 1966-67. A number of slides presenting Hald's exhibition "Oldtidsvæve" at the National Museum, Copenhagen in 1967 are included in the database.

Furthermore, the project received generous funding from both Aage og Johanne Louis-Hansens Fond and from Beckett Fonden during the year. Thanks to these two foundations, the project will continue until February 28th 2022.

Finally, the project group has now found solid evidence of Hald's involvement in the Danish resistance fight during WW2 – more will follow on this subject in 2022!
